

About this week's program:

In September 1780, the discovery of General Benedict Arnold's plot to surrender West Point to the British was a deeply shocking revelation. Arnold, whose name is now synonymous with the word "traitor," was once a well-respected American officer responsible for key victories at Fort Ticonderoga, Crown Point, Fort Stanwix, and Saratoga. While Arnold escaped, his contact in the British army, Major John André, was executed as a spy.

In this session of **Inside the Vault**, we will examine documents relating to Arnold's treason, André's execution, and the reactions of American officers.
